Organization Eligibility

All eligible organizations must be located in the United States or one of its possessions, and must also be recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as tax-exempt, and designated as a public charity under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code.

Ineligible Organizations and Institutions

The following groups are ineligible to receive a grant under the GM Volunteer PLU\$ Program: religious, fraternal, trade, veterans, social, professional, political, private foundations, and college or university athletic programs and funds.

Educational institutions, including public or private elementary, middle or high schools, community colleges, universities or professional schools that are located in the U.S. are also ineligible.

General Motors Corporation reserves the right to deny any grant for any reason, including: the depletion of annually budgeted funds supporting the GM Volunteer PLU\$ Program; the organization represents either a conflict of interest for the volunteer employee, General Motors Foundation, or GM; the organization is determined to represent matters that are considered controversial by GM; or, the application is determined to misrepresent the truth regarding the employee or designated organization.

Application Procedure

Step 1: Volunteer reviews the guidelines, completes and signs Section A of the GM Volunteer PLU\$ application form on the reverse side.

Step 2: An officer of the non-profit organization reviews the guidelines, completes and signs Section B of the GM Volunteer PLU\$ application form on the reverse side, attaching appropriate documentation as indicated.

Employee Eligibility

Any U.S.-based GM employee designated a regular active employee, an active permanent part-time salaried employee, an active hourly employee, an active flexible service salaried employee, a co-op student of GM or any current GM Board member may apply.

Program Guidelines

Through GM Volunteer PLU\$, General Motors Foundation will add to your volunteer impact by awarding a \$250 grant from the GM Foundation to an eligible organization for which you have provided 50 or more hours of donated service within the calendar year.

The donated service may be performed as follows:

- 50 hours by an individual employee on a single project for an eligible organization;
- A series of activities by an individual employee for an eligible organization that totals 50 hours; or
- A team project involving eligible GM employees with a combined contribution of 50 hours to an eligible organization (teams are limited to no more than 10 employees per team). Participating GM Business Units utilizing multiple teams for a single project must first submit a written request to the GM Volunteer PLU\$ processing center for review and pre-approval (identifying the project, the eligible organization, and the projected level of grant monies requested). No monies will be provided prior to the completion of the volunteer hour requirement.

Examples of team participation:

- 3 people feeding the homeless for an eligible organization
- 10 people cleaning up a neighborhood for an eligible organization
- 7 people helping to organize and facilitate a fund-raising event for an eligible organization
- 5 people helping to construct a new house for an eligible organization

GM Volunteer PLU\$ only recognizes volunteer hours of service that have been donated without compensation from the organization receiving the donation of service.

Each eligible employee can apply for a maximum of one (1) individual grant of \$250, and participate in one (1) team grant application of \$250, per calendar year.

Program Policies

GM Volunteer PLU\$ is a program created by General Motors. GM will interpret all policies and program guidelines outlined in this brochure and will determine if any particular application is suitable for a GM Volunteer PLU\$ grant. All decisions will be final.

GM may at any time amend program guidelines, suspend, or discontinue GM Volunteer PLU\$. Applications must be received by January 31 in the year immediately following the calendar year in which the volunteer service was completed.
